


TOOLS AND PARTS OF A CAR



<u>Across</u>

- 1. A power tool used to bore holes into something: DRILL
- 3. A hand tool used for bending wire, holding small objects, etc...: PLIERS
- 5. A hand tool with a metal head on a handle that is used for striking: HAMMER
- 6. An air-filled rubber cover that fits around a car wheel: TIRE
- 7. A piece of metal that covers and protect the engine of a car: HOOD
- 8. Rubber blades that move across the windshield to remove moisture and debris: **WIPERS**
- 9. A device that is used to hold two things together: FASTENER
- 10. It is a bar along the front or back of a car to protect the car from damage during collisions: **BUMPER**
- 11. A machine that blows air, usually to cool something: FAN
- 13. A hand tool that provides extra grip to loosen or tighten nuts, bolts, studs and pipes: **WRENCH**

<u>Down</u>

- 1. The part of the car that has dials and gauges and is located below the windshield: **DASHBOARD**
- 2. The main shaft in the engine that is moved by the connecting rods: CRANKSHAFT
- 4. A hand tool used to drive screws into a surface: SCREWDRIVER
- 12. A device used to lift a car off the ground: JACK
